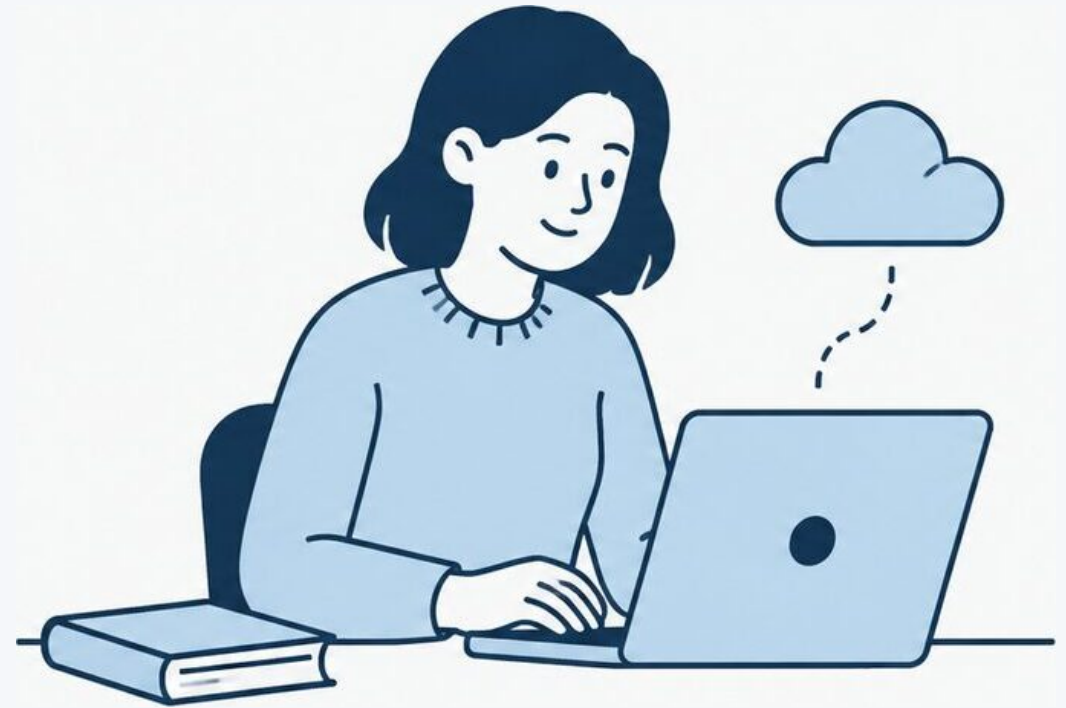

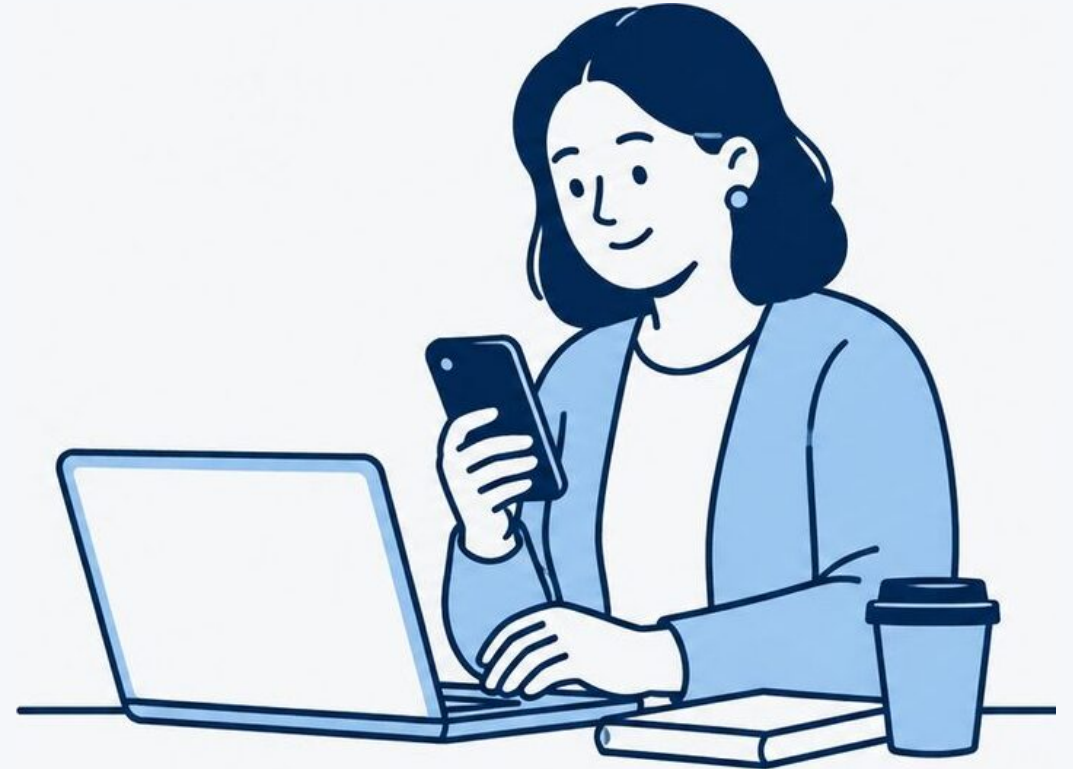


Academic Console sign-in

- Check your name, AI-901 section, elective.



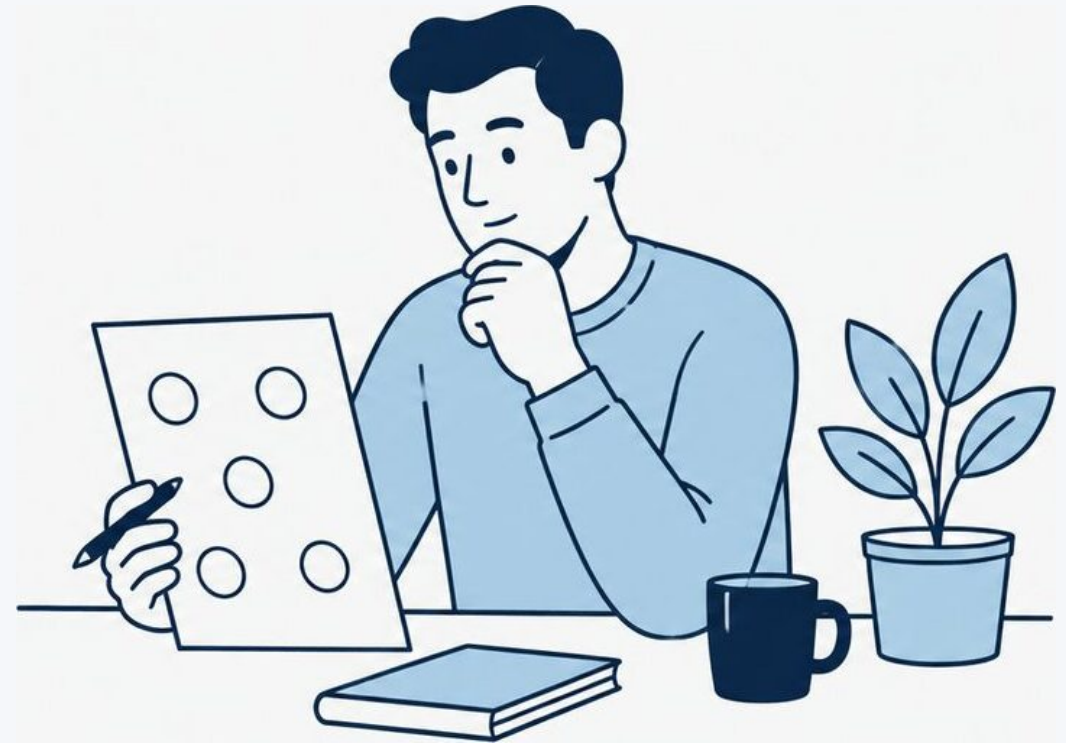
